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Medicaid is an essential part of American health care. It helps improve the health and financial security of millions of Americans every day. Throughout the past year, the Modern Medicaid Alliance and our more than 130 partners have:

- Educated policymakers and the public about the value of Medicaid;
- Highlighted Medicaid's positive impact on the lives of the diverse populations the program serves; and,
- Advocated for solutions to support the growing number of Americans relying on Medicaid amid the COVID-19 pandemic and upcoming Medicaid eligibility redeterminations.

A Commitment to Education and Awareness

Advocating for a Stronger Medicaid Program

With hardworking Americans facing threats to the essential care they need and deserve, the Modern Medicaid Alliance worked with partners to advocate for a stronger Medicaid program.

In February, we sent a <u>letter</u> to congressional leadership urging them to pass bipartisan legislation to bolster Medicaid and expand access to critical services for millions of children, older adults, people with disabilities, veterans, and hardworking Americans. The Alliance also developed and amplified a <u>fact sheet</u> calling on policymakers to improve the redetermination process for Medicaid beneficiaries as the Biden Administration considers unwinding some COVID-19 emergency provisions in the coming months.

Additionally, the Alliance developed and updated partner toolkits with resources focused on maternal and mental health, home and community-based services, as well as Medicaid's role in rural communities:

These efforts were supported by regular, Alliance-wide intel-sharing calls where partners discussed policy and regulatory developments related to Medicaid and coordinated advocacy opportunities.

Promoting Understanding of the Modern Medicaid Program

The Alliance continued its ongoing education efforts to increase awareness and understanding of the value Medicaid delivers. Educational content highlighted Medicaid's role in the lives of pregnant women and new mothers, children, veterans, those with mental health conditions, and rural and underserved communities. We continued to promote the importance of Medicaid in responding to the COVID-19 crisis, and much more.



Medicaid Dashboard

The Medicaid Dashboard continues to serve as a one-of-a-kind resource, providing up-to-date information for partners, policymakers, and the public. In addition to providing the latest, most comprehensive Medicaid enrollment research and polling, the Dashboard also provides state-specific reports for all 50 states plus the District of Columbia.

This year, the Dashboard was updated to showcase newly added Puerto Rico enrollment data. Further, the updated Medicaid Dashboard includes updated data demonstrating how Medicaid reinforced its role as a critical safety net amid the COVID-19 public health crisis.

Partner organizations continue to utilize the data housed on the Medicaid Dashboard to support their policy, advocacy, and communications efforts. The Alliance developed a blog post outlining tips for leveraging the Dashboard to help further partners' goals, including demonstrating the overwhelming support for Medicaid, advocating for policy changes to strengthen Medicaid, and using population-specific data to identify opportunities for partnership with groups that advocate for or work closely with a given population.

The Alliance expanded on our <u>Medicaid Spotlight</u> initiative in 2022, telling the story of how Medicaid helps millions of people every day across the country. Partner Cross-Promotion

In 2022, the Alliance leveraged the social media following of partners to amplify educational and advocacy resources, including a letter to Congress, various toolkits, and Medicaid Spotlight articles.



Paid Media

In addition to cross-promotion efforts amplifying the congressional letter, the Alliance used paid media to target influential audiences in the Beltway last year, reaching a total audience of more than 2,000 individuals.

The Alliance also used paid media to promote the mental health advocacy efforts of Alliance partners in the Beltway to increase awareness and aid our advocacy, reaching a combined audience of nearly 18,000.

Another paid media campaign has recruited more than 3,000 new grassroots email advocates and driven 2.23 million impressions and 49,394 clicks to date.




Amplifying the Medicaid Dashboard
