


What Medicaid Cuts Mean for Alaska




Medicaid is a Lifeline in Alaska

Medicaid plays a critical role in Alaska, supporting the health of children, older adults, people with disabilities and hardworking families — while also providing critical access to care through hospitals, nursing homes and rural providers statewide.


What's at Stake

The proposed Medicaid cuts outlined in H.R. 1 would strip health coverage away from Alaska residents and force significant economic trade-offs, leaving taxpayers footing the bill to cover funding gaps.

The combination of cuts included in the bill would **reduce federal Medicaid funding to Alaska by 12%**, totaling roughly **\$2 billion over the next decade**.¹

Projected Medicaid Coverage Loss in Alaska⁵

If Congress enacts the proposed Medicaid cuts, up to **38,000 Alaskans could lose coverage**. Even under the most conservative estimate, **over 23,000 people would be pushed out of the program** as a result of eligibility restrictions, administrative red tape and reduced funding for outreach and enrollment efforts.



Estimated Economic Impact of Medicaid Work Requirements in Alaska⁶

Work requirements would limit Medicaid eligibility and result in a reduction in economic activity, shrink the workforce and undercut state and local tax revenues.

 **State GDP Loss:**
\$87M – \$118M

 **State & Local Tax Revenue Loss:**
\$3.4M – \$4.6M

 **Total Jobs Lost:**
700 – 900

Congress must protect Medicaid to keep Alaska families healthy and the state economy strong.
