


What Medicaid Cuts Mean for North Carolina

Medicaid is a Lifeline in North Carolina

Medicaid plays a critical role in North Carolina, supporting the health of children, older adults, people with disabilities and hardworking families — while also providing critical access to care through hospitals, nursing homes and rural providers statewide.

Where North Carolina's Medicaid Funding Comes From






What's at Stake

The proposed Medicaid cuts outlined in H.R. 1 would strip health coverage away from North Carolina residents and force significant economic trade-offs, leaving taxpayers footing the bill to cover funding gaps.

The combination of cuts included in the bill would **reduce federal** Medicaid funding to North Carolina by 11%, totaling roughly \$23 billion over the next decade.⁴

Projected Medicaid Coverage Loss in North Carolina⁵

If Congress enacts the proposed Medicaid cuts, up to **384,000 North Carolinians** could lose coverage. Even under the most conservative estimate, over **230,000 people** would be pushed out of the program as a result of eligibility restrictions, administrative red tape and reduced funding for outreach and enrollment efforts.




Estimated Economic Impact of Medicaid Work Requirements in North Carolina⁶

Work requirements would limit Medicaid eligibility and result in a reduction in economic activity, shrink the workforce and undercut state and local tax revenues.

State GDP Loss: \$1.5B - \$2.1B



State & Local Tax Revenue Loss: \$95M – \$132.5M



Congress must protect Medicaid to keep North Carolina families healthy and the state economy strong.
