

## What Medicaid Cuts Mean for North Carolina

## Medicaid is a Lifeline in North Carolina

Medicaid plays a critical role in North Carolina, supporting the health of children, older adults, people with disabilities and hardworking families — while also providing critical access to care through hospitals, nursing homes and rural providers statewide.

#### Where North Carolina's Medicaid Funding Comes From






## What's at Stake

The proposed Medicaid cuts outlined in H.R. 1 would strip health coverage away from North Carolina residents and force significant economic trade-offs, leaving taxpayers footing the bill to cover funding gaps.

The combination of cuts included in the bill would **reduce federal** Medicaid funding to North Carolina by 11%, totaling roughly \$23 billion over the next decade.<sup>4</sup>

#### **Projected Medicaid Coverage Loss in North Carolina<sup>5</sup>**

If Congress enacts the proposed Medicaid cuts, up to **384,000 North Carolinians** could lose coverage. Even under the most conservative estimate, over **230,000 people** would be pushed out of the program as a result of eligibility restrictions, administrative red tape and reduced funding for outreach and enrollment efforts.



#### Estimated Economic Impact of Medicaid Work Requirements in North Carolina<sup>6</sup>

Work requirements would limit Medicaid eligibility and result in a reduction in economic activity, shrink the workforce and undercut state and local tax revenues.

State GDP Loss: \$1.5B - \$2.1B



**State & Local Tax Revenue Loss:** \$95M – \$132.5M
